

Crisis Stabilization Provider Packet Checklist

Documents to be completed for stabilization services:

- Voluntary Services Agreement – This form applies to Crisis Stabilization. It is a form that has been developed by the State of WI, Department of Children and Families. This form should be signed by Parent/Guardian and the child, if the child is 12 year of age or older.
- Crisis Stabilization Admissions Agreement – This form should be signed by the Parent/Guardian and the child, if the child is 12 years of age or older.
- Stabilization Services Face Sheet – This form should be completed with the parent in order to provide the stabilization provider with necessary information to serve the child.
- Releases of Information – This form should be completed so that the stabilization provider can communicate with other providers. It is a multi-agency release. Releases should be between the county and the specific provider. All parties that will be authorized to share information should be listed on the release.

The child should bring with them to crisis stabilization services:

- Any prescribed medications in their original containers.
- Clothing.
- School materials.

*All documents listed above need to be filled out with client and client's guardian.

*All documents in this packet go with client to provider and are required for admission.

*If a copy of completed packet can be made for the county of residence that is optimal, however not necessary.
