



Part-time Registered Nurse (Wisconsin Rapids, WI Area)

Northwest Counseling and Guidance Clinic is a mental health agency that provides intensive, therapeutic day treatment services in many locations statewide to children and adolescents who have severe emotional disorders.

The Northwest Journey program is currently seeking part-time Registered Nurse to serve the Amery and the Siren Sites. You will work directly with children and adolescents as part of a dynamic multidisciplinary team treating emotional and behavioral disorders.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Provides nursing services on-site at Northwest Journey in Wisconsin Rapids.
- Proactively, efficiently, and diligently initiates and continuously pursues effective communication and relationships with medical care clinicians for any and all clients. The RN shall be the primary contact with the Prescribing Medical Clinician.
- Conveys information obtained through observations at day treatment to the prescribing clinician regarding medication effectiveness, PRN medication and overall client functioning. Conveys information from prescribing clinicians regarding medication effectiveness, side effects, and/or use of PRN medications to day treatment staff.
- Communicates with day treatment staff re: any and all information provided by the prescribing clinician.
- Completes and documents regular assessment of all clients including vital signs, height, weight, lung sounds and monitoring of side effects as specified by the prescribing clinician. □ Participates on the treatment team, providing medically-relevant information regarding clients. Reviews and signs appropriate treatment plan and other treatment documents and participates in clinical staffing summaries.
- Provides continuing education (formal and/or informal) for site staff regarding medical and/or medication issues in general and with respect to individual clients as necessary and appropriate.
- Supervises medication distribution through training and oversight of on-site Medication Coordinators. Reviews all documentation of medication distribution.
- Adheres to practice guidelines and ethical standards for Registered Nurses.

Qualifications -- Education and/or Experience

Meet Qualifications for Registered Nurse as defined in DHS Chapter 40:

- A current Wisconsin license and,
- Have had either training in psychiatric nursing, including training in working with children with mental health disorders or one year of experience working in a clinical setting with these children.
