



Mobile On-Call Crisis Worker (Grant County, WI)

We are looking for Mental Health Professionals or persons who have a Bachelor's Degree in a human services related field who are interested in being mobile crisis workers. Mobile workers provide on-site assessment of a person's mental health crisis and collaborate with other professionals to coordinate appropriate services.

This is a part-time, on-call position and shifts are shared between several workers. Scheduling is flexible and this is a great opportunity for supplemental income!

Program Overview and Philosophical Approach:

Emergency Services (Crisis Services) is a collaborative effort between Northwest Connections (NWC) crisis workers, consumers, community members, law enforcement, county personnel, contracted agencies, and community providers to coordinate an immediate response to assist a person experiencing a crisis. NWC recognizes the importance of empowerment and person-centered interventions. The principles of respect, support, and least restrictive treatment guide our interventions. NWC draws on the strengths and coping a person, and work to develop healthy coping in conjunction with the development of natural support systems. Crisis is an opportunity to effect change in an individual's natural environment.

Educational Requirements: Have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in a relevant area of education or human services and a minimum of one year of experience of mental health.

Primary Responsibilities: Respond to a designated secure location to assess individuals experiencing a mental health crisis, assess, and assist in least restrictive safety planning.

Location of Position: Home-Based/On-Call. General response expectation is 30-40 minutes to most locations in the county applying for.

Pay Rate: \$25/8 hour shift on-call (whether or not responding), \$25/hour for assessment time/travel/documentation, .49/mileage reimbursement, and \$15/hour training pay.

Hours/shifts: 4:30pm – 12:30 am Monday through Friday
8:00am – 4:00pm Weekends and Holidays

Additional Information: Must reside in or very near the communities that services are being provided in. This may include: Lancaster, Fennimore, Platteville, and Boscobel, WI.
